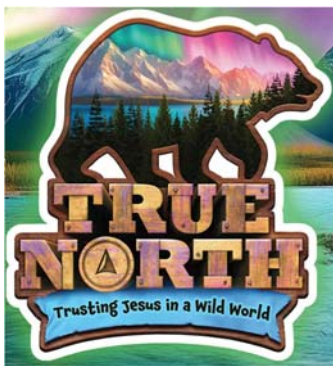

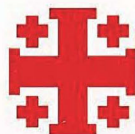

Born in 1942 in the Iasi ghetto, Romania, Abraham Silverman survived thanks to the bravery of those around him. After his father was sent to a slave labour camp, his pregnant mother found refuge with residents who believed that saving Jewish children meant saving the future. Liberated in 1944, his family fled Communist Romania, before finally immigrating to Canada in 1949. From the horrors of war to a new beginning in Saskatchewan, Abraham's story is one of resilience, hope, and survival against all odds. Abe made it his life mission to fight any form of hate, racism and anti-semitism and remains active in this mission to this day.

Your and your community's attendance would not only honour Abraham Silverman, the survivor who will bravely share his story, but also contribute to the ongoing remembrance and education about this critical chapter in history.

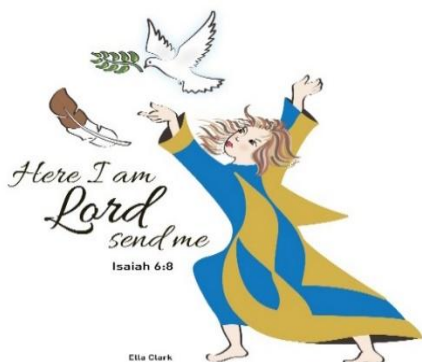

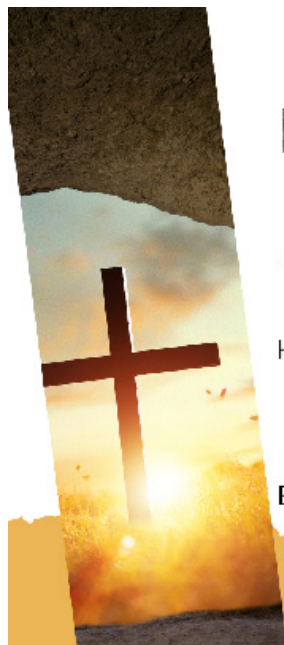

Palm Sunday is the final Sunday of Lent, the beginning of Holy Week, and commemorates the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem, days before he was crucified.



*"My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?"*

Palm Sunday Mass begins in a separate location, usually a parish hall or outside (weather permitting). The Gospel is proclaimed, the palms are blessed, and we process to the Church for the remainder of the Mass, waving our palms and singing the refrain 'Hosanna, Hosanna, in the Highest'.

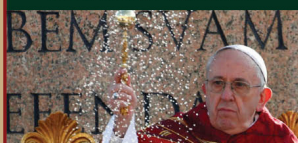
The Passion of Christ is often proclaimed by three persons who take on the roles of the Narrator, the people, and Jesus. The part of Jesus is proclaimed by the priest or deacon of the parish.



### *Palm Sunday* *of the Lord's Passion*

#### Why we have Palms at Mass

In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a young donkey, and to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes, or possibly palms or small branches, in front of him as a sign of homage. This was a customary practice for people of great respect.



> Because the palms are blessed, they may not be discarded as trash. Instead, they are appropriately gathered at the church and incinerated to create the ashes that will be used in the following year's Ash Wednesday observance.

> The colors of the Mass on Palm Sunday are red and white, symbolizing the redemption in blood that Christ paid for the world.

> The use of a donkey instead of a horse is highly symbolic, it represents the humble arrival of someone in peace, as opposed to arriving on a steed in war.
