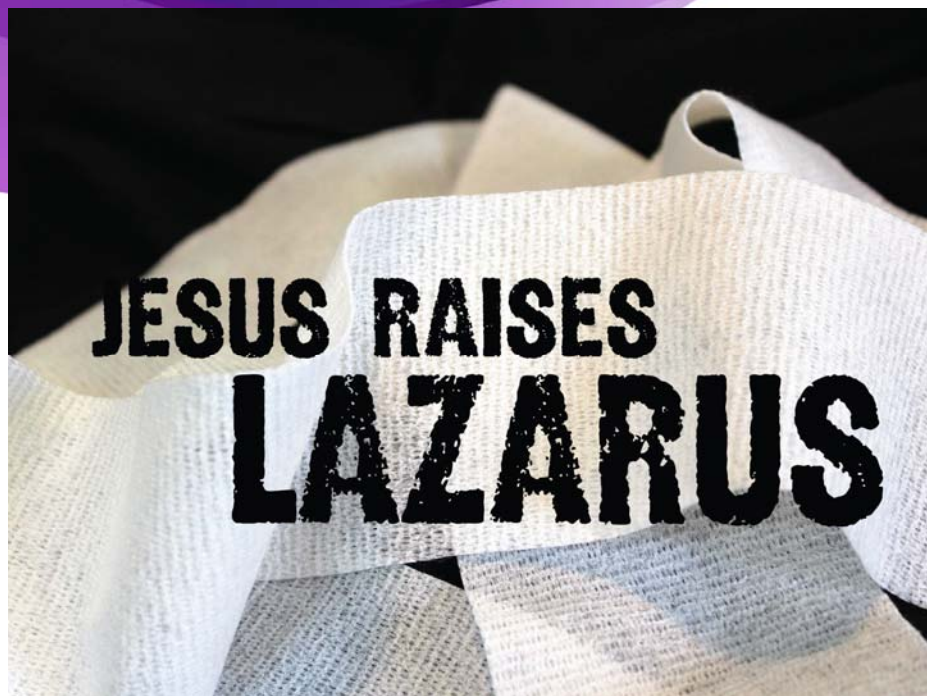

The **PERIOD** of **PURIFICATION** and **ENLIGHTENMENT** is the third phase of **RCIA** preparation and takes place during Lent.

During the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent, all attending 9:00 am Mass will be present for the Scrutinies.

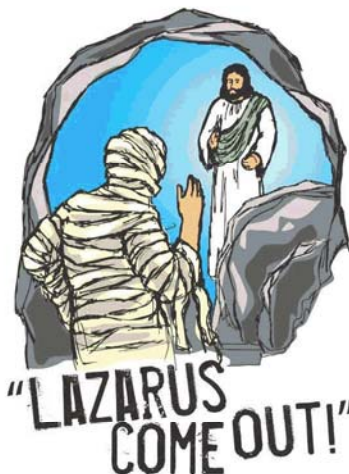
**THE SCRUTINIES** are special rites that help prepare the **RCIA** Elect to enter the Catholic Church — and are for all Catholics seeking to live a life of continuous conversion.

The purpose of the Scrutinies is to work in the hearts of the Elect to:

- *uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful* and
- *strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.*

In this weekend's gospel we hear about Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead, where He reveals Himself as the Resurrection and the Life.

*May we all bear witness to new life in Christ like Lazarus, who received the Resurrection and the Life.*

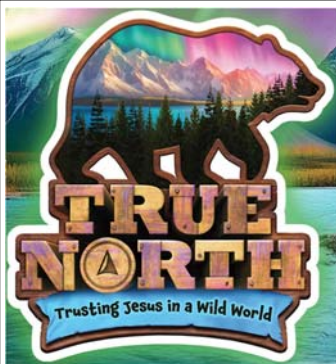

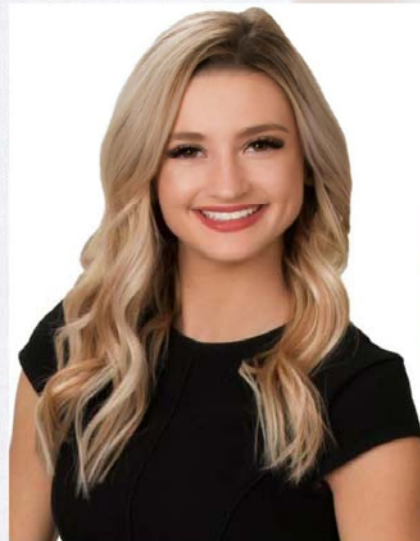

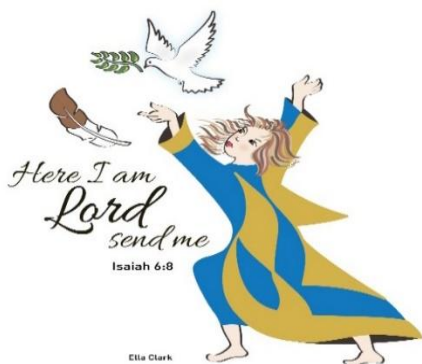
