
## Finance Update

## Revenues:

The year to date Mass collections are \$36,972 lower than budgeted but gratefully the year to date overall donations are \$28,350 higher than budgeted. The 2021 budget was originally planned with the hopes of more people being able to attend Mass earlier in the year, however that did not happen until more recently.

*Expenses:* Management continues to focus on cost effectiveness, our expenses are 8.7% less than budgeted year to date.
