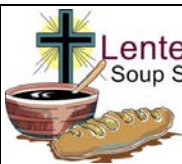

At the Supper of the Lamb



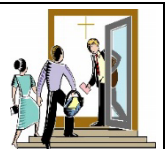

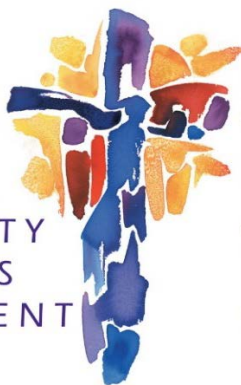
