Our goal as music ministers is to work with other liturgical ministries to create an environment where people in our congregation are drawn closer to God. Our particular focus is to encourage our congregation to praise the Lord in song!

We currently have a number of choirs:

- Junior Youth (Grades 4 and up)
- Senior Youth (high school, university-age)
- Adult groups
- Funeral choir (as needed)
- Baptisms choir (4 times a year)

Time Commitment

Choirs are scheduled on a rotation that is based on the Sunday of the month. The schedule does not typically allocate a choir to a particular time, so you should be prepared to sing/play at any of the 3 mass times. Regular attendance at choir practices is very important. Most groups practice once a week; some have practice times based on the next date the group sings.

Most groups are asked to commit to additional events that require music, such as baptisms, confirmation, reconciliation, RCIA events, and special masses.

The Music Ministry for the summer (July-August) is compiled according to each groups' availability, but most groups do sing in the summer.
