1. Nov Year to Date Financial Results - Operations:

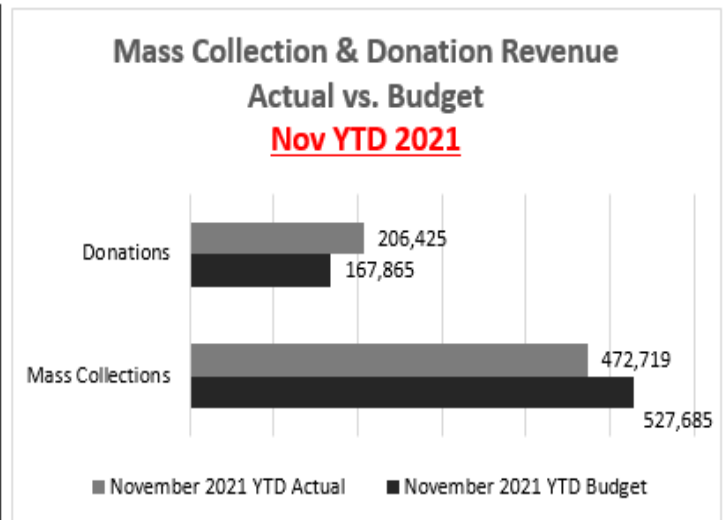
- Nov year-to-date financial results reflect a surplus of \$94,329.
- **A closer look at Mass Collections and Donations:**

Revenues:

The year to date Mass collections are \$54,966 lower than budgeted but gratefully the year to date overall donations are \$38,560 higher than budgeted. The 2021 budget was originally planned with the hopes of more people being able to attend Mass earlier in the year, however that did not happen until mid-year.

Expenses: Our expenses are 4.4% less than budgeted year to date.

2. Remaining debt as of Nov 30th, 2021 is: **\$886,077.**
