Resurrection Parish Financial Update: January to April, 2018

Financial Highlights

- As of April, the Parish is at a Net Loss position of approximately \$38,000.
- Mass Contribution revenue represents approximately 73% of overall revenue.
 2018 is trending behind both 2017 and
 2016. The following table illustrates details:

- Costs to sustain Parish operations in 2018, to April 30, are approximately \$3,460 per day.
- 2018 revenues, to April 30, are approximately \$3,140 per day.
- Repairs and Maintenance costs are anticipated to grow over time. Although the Church was built in 2013, all other areas (Office, Meeting Rooms, Hall and Kitchen) have been in use for about 13 years. As well, the Rectory requires ongoing maintenance as needed. The 2018 budget for Repairs and Maintenance is \$25,000. Year-to-date costs are approximately \$12,000.

Demographic Highlights

The Parish has approximately:

- 2,100 registered families, an increase of approximately 400 families since 2014.
- 1,200 regular donors, with an average annual contribution of approximately \$750.
